DAVID BROMLEY

Born in Sheffield, England in 1960, David Bromley immigrated to Australia at the age of four. The self taught artist became recognised in his early twenties exhibiting throughout Australia. Since then he

has emerged as one of the most recognisable and innovative painters in Australia. His influences although rooted in the 1950's culture – are as distinct as his styles.

Over the past 20 years Bromley's work has fostered wide spread acclaim and notoriety in Australia and internationally. He has exhibited on nearly every continent including Asia, Europe, Africa and America and has been a finalist in the prestigious Archibald prize six times. Bromley's work maintains a Universal appeal by tapping into the collective memory of youth and the wonder of the human existence.

"Despite so many things pointing at the insanity that the modern world is, I choose to be optimistic. And the narratives of my work are too. One of the most important statements and energies that needs to be portrayed is hope. Hope that there is meaning. The jaded youth of today needs to know and believe in beauty and wonder. They need to learn to dream" *Bromley*
