



"Always Offshore" is collaborative project we are involved in with iconic Australian surfer/ shaper Jim Banks. It celebrates the sculptural nature of the surfboard whilst embracing the the strong surf culture that exists in the Margaret River region. For just over 2 years now Gary Bennett and Jim have been working together to create stunning hollow wooden surfboards using traditional torsion box techniques applied to Jim's contemporary designs. The boards feature striking native timbers such as Australian Red Cedar, Queensland Silver Ash, West Australian Sheoak, Jarrah and Marri. They are numbered and dated to ensure long term collectability.

Along with the boards Gary is also developing a range of surfboard inspired furniture designs which sit beautifully with the boards. These pieces also feature Australian Native timbers, are numbered and signed and are highly collectable Jahroc signature pieces.

The project is an ongoing one and many hours of R&D is being spent at some of the best surf locations in the world.
